Additional Comments:

During the first week of December (World Aids Day: 12/1/2014), the team held 4 testing events throughout County that yielded 51 tests, 17.7% of which were to high risk individuals. Negotiations are underway with one of these sites (University of Redlands) to establish a regular ATS in 2015.

Continued collaboration with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation: Ongoing educational workshop series and on site rapid HIV testing are provided at the Day Reporting Center in San Bernardino and Victorville. Clients continue to be interested in testing and in taking the education classes.

Additional Comments:

In January 2015, the HIV prevention team is strategizing on how to increase testing encounters to high-risk individuals in the community. In an effort to create new testing event partnerships with local businesses within certain “hot spots”, the team will focus on identified nightclub venues. Testing is scheduled to begin at one of these venues early in March 2015. In addition, the team has identified new treatment adherence tools to use with HIV positive clients who have demonstrated the need for additional support. We anticipate valuable outcomes as this strategy is implemented.

Continued collaboration with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation: Ongoing educational workshop series and on site rapid HIV testing are provided at the Day Reporting Center in San Bernardino and Victorville. Clients continue to be interested in testing and in taking the education classes.
